# Images on websites:

To display an image on a website we use the <img> tag.

The <img> tag is different from the other tags we've used before as it doesn't have a closing tag.

The src="" part of the image tag tells the computer where the image is. This way the computer can load the image onto the screen. It's very important that the image is in the same folder as the website files, or else it won't load. Now, get an image from google images and save it to the USB. We recommend you rename the image to something like img or download.
